State Fund contribution reports are filed with the State Board of Elections and are (or will be) available on the Board's official website (www.elections.state.il.us/) or for purchase from the State Board of Elections, Springfield, Illinois. Contributions are not deductible for Federal income tax purposes as charitable contributions.
