BLOOMINGTON, Ill. – County Farm Bureau leaders in the 37th Illinois House of Representatives District serving as trustees for Illinois Farm Bureau ACTIVATOR® – the organization’s political action committee – unanimously endorsed Rep. Tim Ozinga for re-election.

Ozinga was unanimously endorsed when county Farm Bureau leaders met to discuss his current voting record.

The new 37th House District will encompass parts of Will and Cook counties.
